ENTRIES

Entries from national organizations shall only be accepted when using the Official Naviga World Championship Entry Form.

Requirements: the national organization is a member of Naviga and the section fee is paid.

The maximum number of competitors in each class is limited to 80. In the case of a higher number of entries, national quotas will be applied.

REGISTRATION

A valid Class Certificate for each boat must be submitted at registration. Boats shall be presented for registration and equipment inspection on period specified in the registration. The Race Committee may extend the time for registration and inspection if there is a valid reason to do so. No boat shall be eligible to race until it has been registered and has passed equipment inspection.

Every national association must provide a national flag (100x150 cm.) as well as their national anthem on pendrive. After the closing ceremony, these items will be returned to the team leader.

FREQUENCIES

The permitted frequency bands are 27, 40, MHz and 2.4 GHz. Each competitor must have a minimum of 4 frequencies available except for 2.4 GHz.

Evaluation and awards:

In every category, the winner is awarded the title of World Champion and his/her country's national anthem is played in his/her honour. The first three competitors in a category receive a medal and a certificate. The other participants also receive a certificate. (In order to have a valid championship, there have to be

* seniors: at least 10 contestants from 5 different countries

* juniors: at least 5 contestants from 3 different countries)
